## **Requirements & Expectations**

#### To be eligible, applicants must:

- Be legally blind (with verification).
- Be accepted or enrolled in an accredited college or university in the United States.
- Be a U.S. citizen.
- Commit to participating in professional development activities.

#### Scholarship recipients must:

- Engage in mentorship activities with an AFB leader.
- Attend one approved annual conference with an AFB staff member.
- Maintain a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA.
